## In Canada, it is NOT against the law to be a sex worker.

Anybody is free to stand in public spaces, i.e. in front of businesses, bus stops or anywhere on the sidewalk. While sex work is not illegal, if you have concerns that your business, home, or organization is being impacted, there are things you can do.

Sex workers often feel threatened and may be scared of you too. They are usually agreeable to moving when they understand there is a concern and are approached politely.

• Acknowledge the sex worker's presence

- Be respectful
- Explain your concerns
- Politely ask them to find a different place to stand
